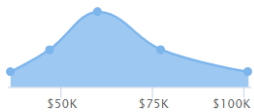

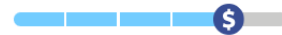
Public relations specialists create and maintain a positive public image for the organization they represent. They design media releases to shape public opinion about their organization and to increase awareness of its work and goals.

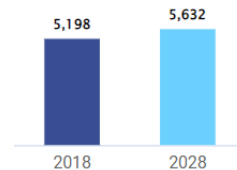

Since public relations specialists work to promote organizations, they spend much of their workdays communicating with people by phone, email, and in face-to-face discussions. They usually work in comfortable offices but also travel to deliver speeches and to attend meetings and community activities. Working within a team is very important in this occupation. Public relations specialists do face a moderate amount of pressure to meet deadlines and to be accurate. Most public relations specialists work full time during regular business hours. Long workdays are common, as is overtime.

Residency Determination Service (RDS)

- The Residency Determination Service (RDS) is a centralized residency service for all students seeking admission to, and **in-state tuition rate** at, a North Carolina college or university and for students seeking to be eligible for the North Carolina **state grant** as part of the their state financial aid package.
- If you have a CFNC.org profile, you will use the same user name and password for RDS. Do not create a new profile for RDS. **CFNC.org and RDS have the *same* user name and password.**
- Go to **ncresidency.org**
- Community colleges will require an RCN to submit your college application. All schools will require at some point.

To be considered for admission to ECSU new freshmen who graduated from high school after June, 1990 must meet the Minimum Course Requirements (MCRs) stipulated by the University of North Carolina. The specific requirements are as follows:

- 4 units of **English** emphasizing grammar, composition, and literature
- 4 units of **mathematics** including two complete units of **algebra I and II**, and **geometry** or a higher level mathematics course for which algebra is a prerequisite
- 3 units of **science** including at least (1) unit of a life or **biological science**, at least (1) unit of **physical science** (for example, **physics** or **chemistry**) and one laboratory course
- 2 units of **social studies** including U.S. history
- 2 foreign languages

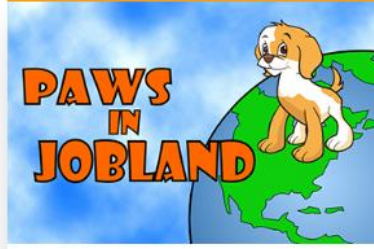

FAFSA Tips for Unaccompanied Homeless Youth

2024-25 FAFSA Form

Providing parent's information on the form:

- If the student answers "yes" to the unaccompanied and homeless question on the FAFSA form, they can complete and submit the form without providing parent's information.

Documentation for homeless/unaccompanied youth:

- After the student answers "yes" to this question, they will be asked whether they have received a homeless youth determination from an individual from one of these agencies:
 - HS or district homeless liaison or designee
 - A financial aid administrator
 - Director of an emergency or transitional shelter, street outreach program, homeless youth drop-in center, or other program serving these students.
 - Director of a project supported by the federal TRIO or GEAR UP program.

FAFSA form requirement for unaccompanied status:

1. Unaccompanied – not living in the physical custody of parent or guardian
2. Homeless – lacking fixed, regular, and adequate housing
3. At risk of being homeless – housing may cease to be fixed, regular, and adequate
4. Self-supporting – pays for their own living expenses, including housing

FAFSA Tips for Unaccompanied Homeless Youth

If a student cannot provide a Homeless Youth Determination:

- Students can still submit the FAFSA as a ***provisionally independent student***, without parent information. They will then need to complete additional steps with the college financial aid office(s) before financial aid eligibility can be finalized. This step will likely include providing documentation from a local school district personnel, state homeless education coordinator, NCHE, high school counselor, mental health professional, social worker, or doctor.

Providing an address on the form:

- The mailing address information on your 2024/25 form will be prefilled. If the address needs to be updated, update it your Account Settings after logging in at studentaid.gov.
- A mailing address must be provided where the student can reliably receive mail. It can be the address of a relative or friend who has given the student permission to use it, or it can be the college's or career/trade school's address.

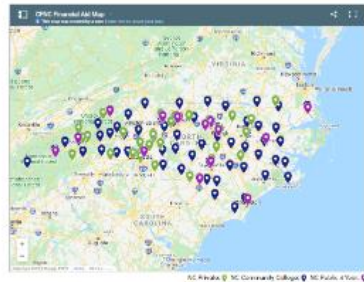

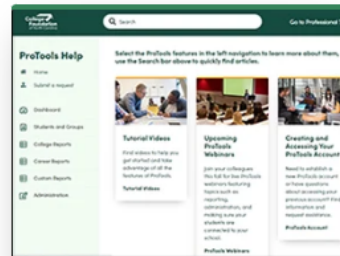
CFNC Professional Tools (ProTools) is an essential companion for educators to support students in career and college planning. Features vary depending on your permissions, but they include:

- Student Finder for finding students connected to your school or organization,
- College Reports for tracking applications, transcripts, RDS, and FAFSA,
- Career Reports for reviewing NCcareers and CFNC career assessment results,
- Custom Reports, and
- Administration for creating bulk accounts and managing permissions.

There are two steps in gaining access to ProTools:

1. Ensure that you have a CFNC.org account tied to your official school/organization email address. You can either create a new CFNC.org account or edit the email address in an existing account (My Dashboard > My Profile).
