Student Identification Percentage

On average, the total number of students identified as experiencing homelessness should represent at least 2% of the LEAs total student population.

Calculate: $\text{Number of Homeless Students} / \text{Average Daily Membership}$

Unaccompanied Homeless Youth Percentage (*defined as child or youth not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian AND lack a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence.*)

On average, the number of unaccompanied homeless youth should represent at least 10% of the LEAs total homeless population.

Calculate: $\text{Number of Unaccompanied Homeless Youth} / \text{Number of Students Experiencing Homelessness}$

Siblings Aged 0-5 Years Old Percentage (*defined as a sibling of an identified student who is not in kindergarten and is also living in the same or another qualifying McKinney-Vento situation.*)

On average, the total number of siblings aged 0-5 years old should represent at least 10% of the LEAs total homeless population.

Calculate: $\text{Number of Siblings Aged 0-5 Years Old} / \text{Number of Students Experiencing Homelessness}$

Nighttime Residence (*Doubled-Up, Hotel/Motel, Sheltered or Unsheltered*)

Calculate: $\text{Number of Homeless Students in Each Living Situation} / \text{Number of Students Experiencing Homelessness}$

Graduation Rate, Drop-Out Rate, Chronic Absenteeism, and Academically Proficient

Compare the total student population versus students experiencing homelessness for each category
