



CFNC and RDS – ONE and DONE

- ✓ Students do "one" residency determination
- RDS and applying for admission via CFNC is seamless
- ✓ RCN automatically prefills in new CFNC application, if student has already completed RDS
- ✓ RDS informs state Grant system
- Students not using CFNC have a simple link to RDS on the college admission application





FAFSA - Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to determine your eligibility for federal and state financial aid. RDS - Use RDS (Residency Determination System) to receive an RCN (Residency Certification Number) to determine your eligibility for in-state tuition and state grant

DACA, Undocumented Parents, and Homeless Students

✓ DACA student is not NC Resident for tuition purposes

- In RDS Online Interview, when asked "Do you claim to be a NC Resident?" – Answer "NO". RDS assigns student an RCN and student can complete college admission applications
- Residency for dependent student is based on parent(s) information. If parent(s) does not have ID #:
 - Student is determined Non-resident and may Appeal in RDS:
 - > RDS specialists work one-on-one with student for determination
- ✓ If a student is experiencing homelessness, RDS alerts student that determination is "Under Review"
 - > RDS reaches out to student by end of next business day
 - RDS helps student to document & validate residency

Students Experiencing Homelessness

- Student continues in interview about residentiary acts (voting, employment, taxes, car registration, high school, etc.) Not everyone is asked ALL the questions
- If student has enough residentiary acts student receives a resident classification; no more information is needed
- If student does not have enough residentiary acts student sees screen (below) notifying them that RDS will contact them within 2 business days to assist them
- RDS team will work with student one-on-one to complete RDS process. No need to complete Reconsideration or Appeal

Students Experiencing Homelessness

- If student does not identify with McKinney Vento in the RDS interview as indicated above:
 - RDS does not flag student as experiencing homelessness and/or needing help
 - RDS asks student the standard interview questions and the student receives a resident or non-resident determination
- It is likely that students who are experiencing homelessness will have trouble providing residency acts, many may receive a non-resident determination
- Student can immediately Appeal, and RDS works with student one-on-one in Appeal to complete residency determination



RDS BASICS

✓ <u>WHY RDS</u>?

> <u>NC LAW REQUIRES RDS TO:</u>

QUALIFY for In-state TUITION at public colleges & universities
 BE ELIGIBLE for NC state GRANT consideration

✓ WHEN SHOULD I DO RDS?

DO RDS FIRST – Before College Admission Applications

- NC Community Colleges -- require your RCN to submit an admission application
- O University of North Carolina -- campuses ask for your RCN as part of their admission process
- NC Independent Colleges and Universities -- check your residency for NC State Grant eligibility



RDS BASICS

- 1. LOGIN to RDS use your CFNC User Name and Password
- UPDATE your Profile (BE ACCURATE SSN and Date of Birth are critical)
- 3. RDS Online Interview: HS student needs parent/legal guardian information
 - social security numbers (or other identifiable number)
 - tax return information
 - vehicle registration
 - driver's license
 - voter registration
 - other information about residency in NC
- 4. UPLOAD documents (RDS tells student if she needs documents not everyone does)



RDS BASICS

✓ REMEMBER:

- **BE ACCURATE** Mistakes cause BIG problems for RDS and College
- FINISH Finish RDS OR request cancelled and start over
- DON'T GUESS RDS checks answers with NC State Agencies Guess/make up answers = non-resident status
- SUBMIT DOCS You have 25 days & are NOT done until RDS has documents

✓ RDS Determination Screen – when you finish, you see:

- RCN Residency Certification Number
- CLASSIFICATION Resident or Non-resident AND In-State or Out-ofstate Tuition
- DOCUMENTS Most students do not need documents RDS tells if you need documents and which ones UPLOAD or send to RDS



RDS BASICS

✓ COLLEGE ADMISSION APPLICATION(S):

- Go to CFNC.org APP HUB
- Go to college website
- Your RCN prefills on CFNC applications
- Enter your RCN when asked on other applications

✓ DON'T AGREE with your determination?

- Login to RDS -- review status, residency classification, & check for required documents
- **<u>RECONSIDERATION</u>** -- Correct or enter additional information
- <u>APPEAL</u> -- Provide special information to prove NC residency) 10 days to request
- Call RDS toll-free: 844-319-3640



Reconsideration

- Allows student to change info about himself, parents/legal guardians, and/or spouse
- Complete this step if student:
 - Had incomplete information or missing data
 - Failed to submit required documents on time
 - Made an error while entering information
 - Has had a change in personal/living situation



Appeal

 RDS Appeal process is for students who have ability or need to provide additional information and documentation to their claim of residency.

 SEAA Statewide Appeal Committee reviews student cases to ensure process is conducted fairly and correctly, and that outcome is correct based on information provided.

In order for a student to receive the benefits of in-state tuition and state financial aid, a residency determination is required from RDS. By creating a new account, you are creating a <u>CFNC.org</u> account. There is no separate account creation for RDS. Should you come back to RDS, simply use your CFNC account to login.

When you create your account, you can:

- · Request your residency determination or review status any time
- Find tools and resources appropriate to your grade or stage of life
- · Store your work, applications, account and other information to pick up or review any time
- · Keep a lifelong portfolio to help with future career transitions; and
- · Get suggestions based on previous web activity




